Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be high school seniors or graduates enrolling as first-year students at an accredited college, university, or vocational institution, maintaining a minimum 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale. They must be full-time students, primary account holders at Members First Credit Union of Florida and have at least one parent or guardian as a primary account holder in good standing. Applications must include one to four academic and personal letters of recommendation and a 500-word essay addressing one of the following topics:

- 1. How credit unions can better serve Gen Z members
- 2. How credit unions better influence our communities

Each essay will be assessed based on its clarity, depth of insight, and relevance to the credit union's mission.
